*Jancis Robinson – 17 Points*

Floral nose, backed up by apricot, peach and a tangy marmalade note. Good zest on the finish. Typically bombastic, but retains balance.

**2015 Saint-Aubin 1er Cru 'En Montceau' Domaine Marc Colin**  
*Wine Advocate – 91 Points*

The palate is well balanced with lemon zest, orange peel and hints of peach all served up with a side order of spice on the finish. Plenty to savour here and the length is impressive.
