The barest hint of wood complements citrus and juicy green notes with clean flavours that offer good freshness and a short crisp finish.

Jancis Robinson - 17 Points

Floral nose, backed up by apricot, peach and a tangy marmalade note. Good zest on the finish. Typically bombastic, but retains balance.

Wine Advocate - 91 Points

The palate is well balanced with lemon zest, orange peel and hints of peach all served up with a side order of spice on the finish. Plenty to savour here and the length is impressive.

2016 Crozes-Hermitage, La Matiniere, Ferraton, Rhone, France

Expressive and perfumed Syrah, with notes of succulent black cherry, toast, meat and violets. The tannins are silky and in perfect balance with the fresh acidity. The finish is long and harmonious.

2017 Domaine Drouhin, Pinot Noir, Dundee Hills, Oregon, U.S.A

Subtle notes of rose petal, raspberry and dark cherries lead into layered flavours of sour cherries, cranberry, black tea, and plum. Although young, there is an extraordinary balance between the fine tannins and energizing lift of vibrant red fruit and acidity.

2017 Ridge Vineyards, Lytton Springs, Zinfandel, Syrah, Sonoma, U.S.A

Lytton Springs has become synonymous with classic Dry Creek zinfandel. It shows potent, ripe boysenberry and blackberry, but also a pronounced rusticity and earthiness often attributed to its blending varietals; petite syrah and carignan. Acid and tannin are firm, yet not overwhelming; in youth, at least, fruit predominates.

2012 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Omnia Rotem & Mounir Saouma, France

Wine Spectator - 92 Points

Vinified with 100% whole cluster and aged two years in barrel (on lees) with no racking before being bottled unfiltered and unfiltered. It has a creaminess and suppleness (no doubt due to the extended lees contact) to go with terrific notes of black raspberries, crushed flowers, incense and Asian spice. Medium to full-bodied, fresh, tight and lively, yet with good richness.

 From one of the most celebrated producers of English Wine. This has excellent intensity of fruit combined with a fine mousse and long finish that has flavours of roasted almonds and baked peaches. Excellent!
